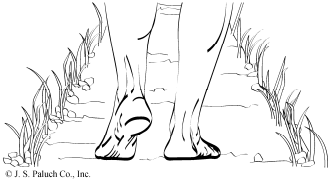

The Lazarus At Our Door ministry is a way that we help one another care for those in need. - A couple living in their car are both disabled and need housing (they have SSI income).

- A woman is looking do some part-time house cleaning work.
