THE MASS NEVER ENDS—IT MUST BE LIVED! FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

We are invited to continue to reflect upon the Gospel reading (John 13:31-35) and homily as we live out our Eucharist this week. Reflect upon it in your heart and mind, and discuss it with your family, friends and faith community members.

- Think of a time when you were impressed by how people really loved one another. How could you tell that they loved one another? How did that encounter make you feel about yourself and your own life and relationships?
- Jesus basically seems to be saying that true Christianity and all its moral and theological precepts boil down to this: that we really love one another as Jesus has loved us. Our “practice of the faith” is really about our relationships with other people – do we love them as Jesus loves us? Jesus calls this “a new commandment.” Is this perspective on our practice of religion new to you? Is following this “new commandment” your primary focus as you set out to live each day and your standard of evaluating the successes and failures of each day lived? How would your life be different if it were?
- There are many things that go by the name of “love,” but in this gospel Jesus is defining love as how he has loved us. If we want to know what real love is, we have to see and experience how Jesus loves us. How has Jesus loved you? Based on this love of Jesus, what is love?

COPA MEETING

AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR (AED)

Resurrection Church has embarked on implementing an AED (Automated External Defibrillator) Program. An AED is a device that can be used to rapidly respond to life-threatening emergencies such as Sudden Cardiac Arrest. The program will improve the chain of survival for victims while EMS is traveling to our site location. The parish staff and various parishioners will become trained responders. The staff and one of our parishioners received CPR/AED training in April. Several other parishioners will receive this training as well. Thank you to Joshua Atiba, MD, Gennaro Malzone, and David Harken who were responsible for developing the plan and gaining support. Our plan has been approved the Santa Cruz County EMS, Aptos/La Selva Fire Protection District and the Diocese of Monterey. We have two AED's. One is located in the church to the left of the front doors in the corner near the kiosk and the second one is located in the hall near the doorway from the hallway near the offices to the main body of the hall.

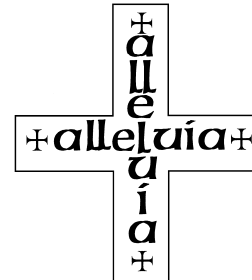

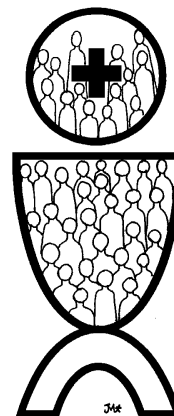
