Did you know?... "The true story of Santa Claus begins with Nicholas, who was born during the third century in the village of Patara . . . on the southern coast of Turkey. His wealthy parents, who raised him to be a devout Christian, died in an epidemic while Nicholas was still young. Obeying Jesus' words to "sell what you own and give the money to the poor," Nicholas used his whole inheritance to assist the needy, the sick, and the suffering. He dedicated his life to serving God and was made Bishop of Myra while still a young man. Bishop Nicholas became known throughout the land for his generosity to those in need, his love for children, and his concern for sailors and ships."

  - December 25: Christmas 10:00 AM






If you can't attend Mass at the times offered at Resurrection you can check Mass times at other Catholic Churches in our area.
